Projects entered into the Awards must have reached completion at least to the point of enabling assessment by the judging panel. Projects may cover a range of scales and types, both large and small, as defined by the four awards categories and the [selection criteria](#).

The 2016 Logan Urban Design Awards were awarded in the following categories:

- [Master Planning Award](#) - Awarded to master planned developments and communities
- [Architecture Award](#) - Awarded to exemplar built form projects (residential, commercial, industrial or institutional)
- [Landscape Architecture and Urban Infrastructure Award](#) - Awarded to exemplar public realm works
- [Business and Events Award](#) - Awarded to exemplar businesses, programs or events that contribute to a coherent and appealing urban environment

Master Planning Award

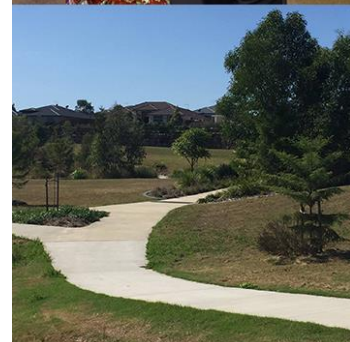
Winner: My Home and The River Estate
