

Logan City Council endorsed the Logan Village Local Plan on 30 March 2010, guiding development for the area over the next 20 years and allowing Logan Village to cater for the needs of its existing and future residents. The plan was incorporated into the Logan Village Local Plan as part of the Logan Planning Scheme 2015 which commenced on 18 May 2015.

Building on this planning, we are transitioning from the 'visioning' to 'doing' and will now focus on how government, industry, business, land owners and the community can build a vibrant and thriving river destination shaped by its heritage, to serve business and the surrounding community.

The Logan Village Forum was held on **7 March 2018** and brought together the community, key government, industry, business owners and landowners to collaborate on how to unlock the economic and place making potential for Logan Village. Attendees provided input for key projects that will be implemented over the short, medium and long term to realise the vision of creating a vibrant river destination, shaped by its heritage.

#### Logan Village Forum Outcomes

At the conclusion of the Logan Village Forum and community consultation period, a total of 335 submissions were received with 490 ideas on the future of Logan Village. A summary of all the forum ideas resulted in the identification of 29 key actions and comprising of 45 initiatives that align with the four urban design themes. These have been outlined in the Logan Village Forum Outcomes Summary.
