Springwood Implementation Projects – Slacks Creek Green Link

Introduction

Logan City Council is committed to develop the potential of Springwood's centre as a major commercial activity hub.

In June 2017, Council endorsed a budget allocation of \$5 million to establish an Implementation Fund for the Springwood Activity Centre that will be focused on infrastructure and project delivery of the key priority projects identified from the Springwood Summit held in 2016. One of the identified projects is the Slacks Creek Green Link Shared Pathway between Bakers Street and Moss Street in Springwood.

The project aims to create a green link and recreational corridor along Slacks Creek that will connect Moss Street with Compton Road and create connectivity with a regional network of principal cycle ways, including the future Compton Road and Baker Street Bikeway. The 3m wide pathway will meander through parkland leading to pockets of active and passive recreation nodes. A bridge will connect both sides of the creek and will act as a sculptural feature in the landscape.

The project will create an active transport link and recreational corridor along Slacks Creek for pedestrians and cyclists and will benefit local businesses by attracting people to the area.

Project Facts

- \$3.2 Million overall project budget.
 - Contribution of \$827,000 from Queensland State Government Cycle Network Local Government Grant (CNLGG)
- A concrete pathway approximately 780m in length that varies between 3-4m in width including feature pavement, boardwalk and retaining walls.
- Bridge crossing and boardwalk that connects both sides of the creek.
- Landscaping works within the Slacks Creek waterway.
- Lighting
- CCTV security cameras
- Bench seats along the pathway
- Artwork structures along the pathway
- Bike shelters along the pathway in designated location
- Refuse bins and dog waste bins along the pathway
- Wayfinding and interpretive signage.

Construction to commence September 2019. Anticipated completion March 2020
