Logan City Council is committed to developing the potential of Springwood's business centre as South-East Queensland's next CBD.

The Springwood Summit was held on **21 October 2016**. Over 220 invitees attended, including experts in place design, infrastructure policy, urban innovation and development, to share national and international perspectives on making Springwood a smart and liveable centre.

The summit sought to address three questions in co-creating a future Springwood:

1. What are the key projects, ideas and initiatives for a future Springwood?
2. What are the triggers to realising these projects and why have they not occurred?
3. Creating a roadmap – who needs to invest?

Springwood Summit endorsed outcomes

On 14 March 2017 Council endorsed the [Springwood Summit Outcomes Summary](#) which includes 10 primary actions and 30 initiatives that were identified from the Springwood Summit for implementation.

All the outcomes from the summit have been included in the [Springwood Implementation Plan](#) which was endorsed by Council on 17 October 2017.

Summit theme one: Collaboration and Creativity

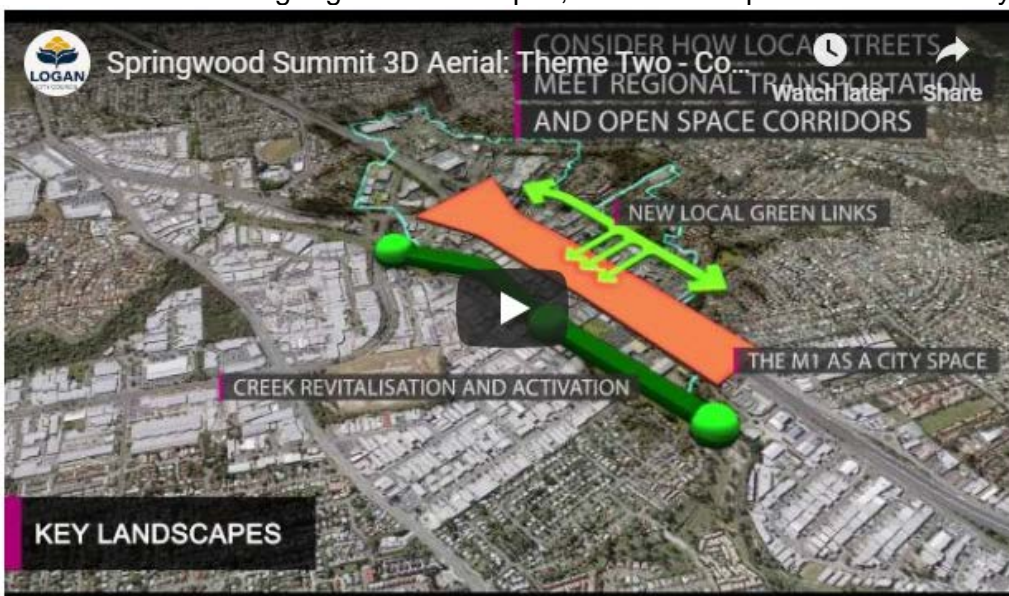

This 3D aerial video of Springwood, in the City of Logan, depicts our social and green infrastructure including regional landscapes, local landscape corridors and key landscapes.



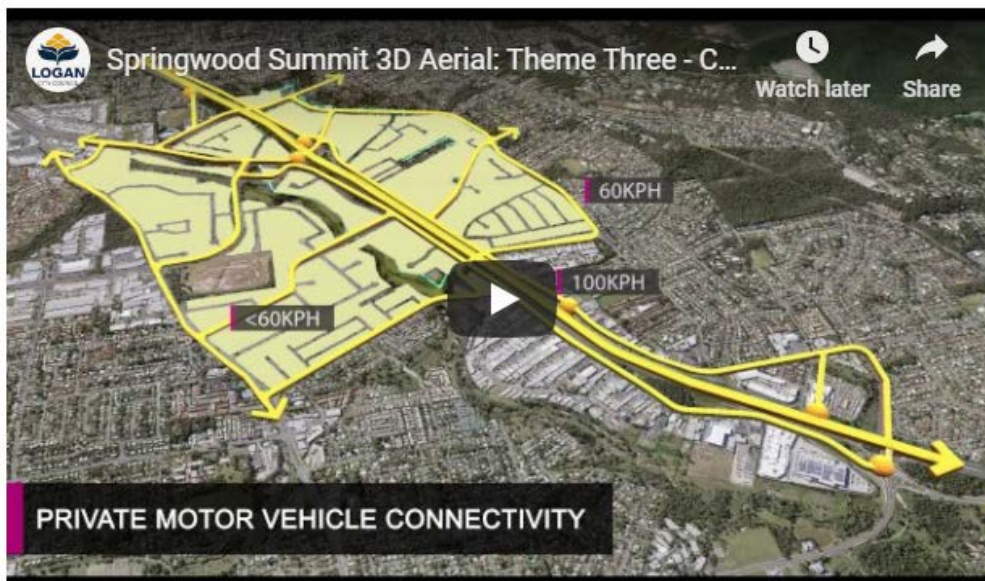
